<b>Pinot Noir, Mark West, CA</b>	<b>\$7.25</b>	<b>\$27.00</b>	<i>This wine has aromas of strawberries, raspberries and faint camp fire. On the taste you find strawberry, juicy watermelon and cherries.</i>
<b>Pinot Noir, Kenwood, Russian River, CA</b>		<b>\$34.00</b>	<i>Flavorful aromas of fresh raspberries and cherries followed by subtle notes of vanilla and cola.</i>
<b>Merlot, Blackstone, CA</b>	<b>\$7.25</b>	<b>\$27.00</b>	<i>Dark cherry and berry aromas, with oak spices, clove and nutmeg.</i>
<b>Merlot, Raymond R. Collection, Napa, CA</b>		<b>\$34.00</b>	<i>A big fruit forward merlot that opens with aromas of black cherry, raspberry, plum, chocolate, black pepper and fills the mouth with blackberry, spicy oak, and black licorice.</i>
